

😊 RVC Kids Camp – Sundays this Summer 😊

Dear RVC Families,

We are very excited to kick off our children's ministry summer program! This summer, we would like to incorporate some aspects of "R-Camp" into our Sundays at RVC – this will include continued biblical teaching with support from the Parent Cue curriculum, along with some additional opportunities for the kids to bond with each other, promote teamwork, inspire creativity, and enjoy creation outdoors! Here's what you need to know:

SCHEDULE: We will be checking in kids at the welcome table as usual, but kids will be dismissed from being seated with their parents after the first few songs and prior to communion to allow for more time with planned activities. Please check out all school-aged children (including preteens and teens) from the courtyard no later than 12pm. *Nursery drop off and pickup will remain upstairs for the toddler/preschool class*

COST: For the school-aged children (nursery excluded), we are asking for a donation of **\$20 per child** to subsidize costs for the duration of our summer program. Included in this cost is a Roanoke Valley Church t-shirt they can wear on Sundays, that will correspond with the color of their "cabin" (team). Our children's ministry fund will cover the remainder costs of snacks, crafts, and activities. Please make sure to let us know t-shirt size for your child (youth, men and women sizes available). Payment can be via cash, check or venmo to Roanoke Valley Church (RVC Kids Camp in memo).

Please don't hesitate to let us know if this is financially not feasible for you

COUNSELORS IN TRAINING: Michelle Young & Lindsay Landis will be overseeing the summer program and recruiting support from some of our teens to assist. Please let us know if your teen is interested in helping and we will work on assigning them a responsibility they will thrive with! We expect

our CIT's to set a positive example for the rest of the campers because they will surely be looking up to them (1 Timothy 4:12). This is also a great opportunity to gather community service hours if needed!

HOW CAN YOU HELP? We will do our best to provide all materials needed, but we may send out a wish list to see if items are available among our fellowship. Occasionally we may ask you to send something in with your child but will give plenty of notice on this. Please send your kids in comfortable clothing/shoes they can wear for outdoor play, along with a labeled water bottle, because we plan to get outside every day that weather permits. If you have materials for a craft/activity that may be suitable for camp, we are always welcome to ideas and donations!

We are so looking forward to making great spiritual and fun memories with RVC Kids this summer! In August we will plan to close our camp with a small showcase performance at church (stay tuned for date/details) 😊
